PECTUS CARINATUM

Pectus carinatum is one of the most common chest wall deformities. WCBL has developed the WPC Compressor and alternate versions of the Compressor, to provide a conservative alternative treatment to surgical correction.

SCOLIOSIS

Scoliosis is a progressive condition that when managed correctly with bracing can yield a slowing to halting of the curve progression. Our Orthotists work well with area orthopedists and neurologists in the treatment of neuromuscular juvenile, and adolescent idiopathic scoliosis.

PEDIATRIC TRAUMA

Accidents happen! For pediatric traumatic spinal management, we offer cervical collars, halos, CTOs, Minerva, the Papoose, and custom back braces to promote the desired level of immobilization to allow for proper healing to take place. We also offer a variety of solutions for long and short bone fracture management, contracture management, post-amputation limb protectors, and custom burn masks.
